National Cancer Survivors Day Highlights People Living with Disease: Dr. Francisco Contreras tells how patients can add years to their lives

WHAT: National Cancer Survivors Day will be observed Sunday, June 6, with hundreds of cities throughout the nation hosting celebrations. President Barack Obama and Dr. John E.
